

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

Nominations from Active members are requested for various administrative roles in the management of the EAPD, elected members will take office at the EAPD Congress in Strasbourg, on May 25th, 2012, during the General Assembly. The Bylaws of the EAPD determine that each elected member shall serve for no more than six years in any one position. Below are the names of the present members of the EAPD Board and the year of first appointment.

Executive Board

- President: Norbert Kraemer (2008) automatically becomes past-President
- President-elect: Monty Duggal (2010) automatically becomes President
- President-elect: nominations required
- Secretary: Paddy Fleming (2006): nominations required
- Treasurer: Teresa Leisebach (2010): is continuing

The nomination committee also wants nominations by the local organizations send to the Chairman as above, for the following committees:

- Education committee (3 members)
- Credentials committee (1 member)
- Nomination committee (3 members)
- Clinical affairs committee (4 members)

Finally, members of the EAPD Council are nominated or elected by their local organizations of paediatric dentists. As with all positions, incumbents may serve for only six years.

The following Councilors have served their term of 6 years and should be replaced in the Council: Belgium, Croatia (proposal received), Finland (proposal received), France, Ireland, Italy, Netherlands (proposal received), Norway, Portugal, Russia, Spain (proposal received), Sweden, Turkey, UK.

All above countries should send their nominees for Councilors again as above to the Chairman of the Nominations committee.
