



## 1st EAPD Athena Master Class for Young Paediatric Dentists

Using anatomically prefabricated activators for the treatment of malocclusion in the primary and mixed dentitions

Münich (Freising), Germany 27<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> October, 2017

### Course objectives:

The aim of the Master Class is to provide Paediatric Dentists with thorough understanding of early treatment of different malocclusions with prefabricated eruption guidance appliances. Treatment options of the various malocclusions including the oral habits during primary and mixed dentition are covered. A great number of case series will support the theoretical approach. As solid evidence based treatment planning is necessary, results of related clinical research and the scientific basis of growth and the development of the dentition and malocclusions are presented and analyzed.

### Lecturers:

#### Dr. Gioacchino Pellegrino, DDS, Specialist in Orthodontics (Italy)

Dr. Pellegrino graduated with honors from the University of Naples in 1985 and he is working in his private orthodontic clinic in Caserta, Italy. In 1993, Dr Pellegrino completed his postgraduate training in orthodontics and thereafter he has participated in a great number of continuous education courses in various topics of orthodontics. He is Adjunct Professor of Orthodontics at the University of Foggia. He is also Adjunct professor in Postgraduate in Pedodontics and previously in Postgraduate in Orthodontics at the university of Naples Federico II in Italy. He is frequently invited Lecturer in National and International Conferences and private courses. He has published several peer-reviewed papers and he is a member of several dental and orthodontic Societies, including ANDI, SIDO, IBO and EBO.



#### Dr. Minna Ehrnrooth, DDS, Specialist in Orthodontics (Finland)

Dr. Minna Ehrnrooth graduated from Turku University, Finland in 1991 and completed her specialization training in orthodontics in 2007. She is working as Chief Dental Officer at Vaasa Central Hospital in Finland since 2011. In addition to her work at the hospital, she is Consultant orthodontist at the area health care centers offering dental care and early orthodontic treatment for children. One of her main duties is to consult and supervise dental staff working at the Health Centers for the ways avoiding future occlusal problems using early intervention with eruption guidance appliances. She is a member of several scientific Societies.

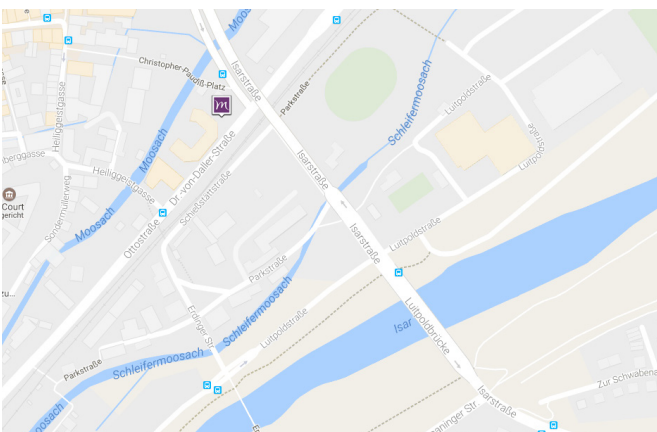
